



**DAVID J TAYLOR** - Engineer/Producer/Songwriter, Twisted Pair Productions (CAN)

David j Taylor (or "djt" is he is often called) has had many accomplishments in his 20 years working in the Music/Entertainment Industry. He is an Award-Winning (WMCA Producer of the Year '07) and Multiple Award Nominated Record Producer/Engineer/Mixer/Musician and Arranger with close to 90 album production credits to his name from 1990-2011 (Megan Nash, Geoff Berner, Despistado, Meghan Bowman, Sylvie, Ultimate Power Duo).

David is a prolific Singer-Songwriter/Recording/Touring Artist, having released 15 albums since 1990. In November 2010 The LP "Heartaches and Numbers" by "Semko, Fonatine, Taylor" (featuring David alongside Kim Fontaine and

Northern Pikes front-man Jay Semko) was released on Busted Flat Records/Universal. "SFT" showcased at SXSW 2011 and toured throughout the year in support of the record. David is very excited to announce the forthcoming release of his newest solo studio album "Goodbye Hazel" in the fall of 2011. David has also placed numerous songs/co-writes in sync to Film/TV Series the world over ("Degrassi, The Next Generation", "Stoked", "The Guard", The Theatrical Feature Film "Surveillance" by Jennifer/David Lynch with official showcase at The Cannes Film Festival 2008).

David is a composer (various TV/Radio Campaigns: Sasktel, Conexus Credit Union, SaskEnergy, City of Regina) and has been a Voice-Over Artist for numerous Radio/TV spots. In 2011, David co-wrote the new Saskatchewan Rough Riders Pep song "Ride On" with Megan Nash and will be performing during the 2011 Grey Cup in Vancouver.

In audio post production David was a 2010 Gemini Award Nominee for Best Sound for "The Saskatchewan River Delta" and was a 5-time Gemini Award Nominee during the 2000s for his foley fx recording/performance work on "renegadepress.com", "Corner Gas" and the film productions "The Englishman's Boy", "Betrayed" and "Prairie Giant, The Tommy Douglas Story". David is also a Music Supervisor ("renegadepress.com" seasons 1-5, numerous TV Ads) and Re-Recording Mixer for TV/Film ("Landscape as Muse", "The Bionic Bannock Boys", "Remote Control War").

David has spoken at numerous music industry events over the years (WCMA/Breakout West, PMW, SXSW) and has been a guest lecturer for The University of Saskatchewan, The University of Regina and at various SaskMusic events. David and close friends Fontaine and Semko also instruct the Annual U of S Emma Lake Songwriting retreat at The Kenderdine Campus in Northern Saskatchewan.

David and his partner own a 20-acre horse farm/project studio at Milestone SK (Hazelwood Farm) where Russ raises and trains world caliber show horses and David gets to make his music "as loudly as he wants to/whenever he wants to" in the peace and quiet of the country.

David has worked full time for Twisted Pair Productions since late 2008; Regina's premier recording studio/production facility where David uses most of the above skills during any given work week.
